The applicant has filed this OA challenging the communication dated 03.03.2016 issued by the Adjutant for Flight Commander, R&O FR, PIN 925421 C/O.99 APO intimating the applicant that unless he improves his performance and maintains high standard of personal discipline in the Unit and avoid any further disciplinary action against him, he may earn four or more Red Ink entries which may be the ground of discharge from service.

It is evident from the aforesaid communication dated 03.03.2016 that the applicant has simply been informed/warned to improve his performance and also to avoid any further disciplinary action which may, in turn, be the ground for his discharge from service in future, if the occasion so arises. The said communication does not give rise to any cause of action for the applicant to file this OA.

Hence, the OA stands dismissed.

It would, however, will not preclude the applicant to approach the appropriate authority at the appropriate point of time, if any decision relating to his discharge from service is taken by the concerned authority.
